(1) On February 25, 2014, 60,030 restricted shares of Mr. Welch's newly-granted Company stock vested. On March 3, 2014, Mr. Welch automatically surrendered 27,925 of the 60,030 newly-vested shares to the Company to satisfy tax withholding obligation triggered upon the February 25th vesting. The automatic surrender of newly-vested shares is the Company's default process for paying tax withholding obligations triggered upon the vesting of restricted stock.

(2) On February 25, 2014, 16,666 restricted shares of Mr. Welch's newly-granted Company stock vested. On March 3, 2014, Mr. Welch automatically surrendered 7,825 of the 16,666 newly-vested shares to the Company to satisfy tax withholding obligation triggered upon the February 25th vesting. The automatic surrender of newly-vested shares is the Company's default process for paying tax withholding obligations triggered upon the vesting of restricted stock.

(3) The price reported in Column 4 is a weighted average price. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$24.75 to \$25.05, inclusive.
