EXPLANATORY NOTE

This registration statement is being filed solely for the purpose of registering 2,185,444 additional shares of common stock, par value \$.01 per share (the Common Stock), of ImmunoGen, Inc. (the Company) to be offered to participants under the Company s 2006 Employee, Director and Consultant Equity Incentive Plan (the 2006 Plan), originally adopted in 2006. The maximum number of shares of Common Stock reserved and available for issuance under the 2006 Plan includes 2,500,000 shares, which were previously registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the Commission) on Form S-8 (File No. 333-138713 filed on November 15, 2006) (the 2006 Registration Statement), an additional 2,000,000 shares which the Company s shareholders authorized for issuance under the 2006 Plan on November 12, 2008, plus the number of shares underlying any grants previously made under the Company s Restated Stock Option Plan (the Restated Stock Option Plan) that are forfeited, canceled or are terminated (other than by exercise) from and after November 11, 2006. An aggregate of 185,444 additional shares have been included in the shares reserved for issuance under the 2006 Plan as a result of the forfeiture, cancellation or termination (other than by exercise), during the period between November 1, 2007 and October 31, 2008, of grants previously made under the Restated Stock Option Plan.
