- (1) 401(k) Plan: This amount includes shares and dividends acquired pursuant to the H.B. Fuller Company Thrift Plan.
- (2) 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: 2,704 restricted shares were awarded pursuant to H.B. Fuller Company's 2000 Stock Incentive Plan and vest effective December 1, 2008. Total amount also includes restricted shares acquired pursuant to a dividend accrual feature of the 2000 Stock Incentive Plan.
- (3) Amended and Restated 2000 Stock Incentive Plan: 1,666 restricted shares were awarded pursuant to H.B. Fuller Company's Amended and Restated 2000 Stock Incentive Plan and vest effective December 4, 2009.
