- (1) Includes 12,750 shares of restricted stock which vest on 11/1/2011.

Phantom stock units representing dividends which relate to vested deferred awards are payable in cash following the reporting person's termination from the issuer, and may be transferred into an alternative investment account. Vesting continues when the reporting person retires from the issuer.
- (5) Includes 301.956 phantom stock units acquired through the reinvestment of dividends on January 4, 2010 at \$27.80 per phantom stock unit, of which 112.589 were accrued on the vested and disposed phantom stock units.
