- Reinvestment of dividends on shares held in Reporting Person's share deferral account (the "Plan Account") pursuant to the MetLife, Inc. 2000 Directors' Stock Plan. The amount of shares beneficially owned following the reported transaction may include adjustments in the Reporting Person's Plan Account to reflect the accumulation of fractional shares into whole shares.
- (1) During December 2005, the Plan trustees liquidated 64.77 Plan Shares allocated to, and indirectly held by, reporting person. The cash proceeds of such liquidation were paid to the reporting person pursuant to the federal income tax minimum distribution rules, which require that a retired employee who has attained age 70 1/2 or older receive a minimum amount each year from the Plan, determined by reference to the reporting person's life expectancy.
- (2) 401(k) reflects shares (the "Plan Shares") allocated to, and indirectly held by, reporting person under the MetLife Savings and Investment Plan (the "Plan"). Due to period end adjustments by the Plan trustee to allocate Plan units to shares, the Plan Shares reported as acquired by reporting person may not equal the Plan Shares reported as being owned at the end of the period covered by this report.
- (3) Shares held in trust under MetLife Policyholder Trust established to hold shares of Common Stock allocated to eligible policyholders of Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, a wholly-owned subsidiary of MetLife, Inc.
