(1) In October 2005, the issuer paid a special dividend of \$2.50 per share of common stock to all stockholders of record as of the close of business on September 30, 2005. In connection with this special dividend, the issuer's Board of Directors adjusted all options that were awarded, but not exercised, prior to the ex-dividend date for the special dividend to account for the effect of the special dividend. The

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number of shares subject to each such option was increased and the exercise price correspondingly decreased such that each option had the same fair value to the holder before and after giving effect to the payment of the special dividend. Pursuant to this adjustment, the number of shares underlying Mr. Johnston's options increased by 1,354 from 37,500 to 38,854 and the per share exercise price was correspondingly decreased.

- (2) Includes 78.9526 shares that the Reporting Person acquired pursuant to the Boston Properties, Inc. 1999 Non-Qualified Employee Stock Purchase Plan in January 2006.
- (3) The options vested in three equal annual installments beginning on January 17, 2003.
