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Item 5.02 Departure of Directors or Principal Officers; Election of Directors; Appointment of Principal Officers.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on August 1, 2006, the Board of Directors of Aqua America, Inc. (the "Board") appointed two new directors to the Board. Mr. Andrew J. Sordoni III, former chairman and president of C-TEC Corporation, the parent company of Commonwealth Telephone, was appointed to the class of directors with terms expiring at the 2007 Annual Meeting of Shareholders. Ms. Ellen T. Ruff, president of Duke Energy Carolinas, was appointed to the class of directors with terms expiring at the 2008 Annual Meeting of Shareholders. The Board has also appointed Ms. Ruff to the Executive Compensation and Employee Benefits Committee of the Board and Mr. Sordoni to the Audit Committee of the Board (the "Audit Committee"). Mr. Sordoni replaces Dr. Constantine Papadakis on the Audit Committee. Dr. Papadakis will continue as a member of the Corporate Governance Committee of the Board.
