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Item 5. Other Events and Regulation FD Disclosure.

On October 10, 2003, the Registrant completed the private placement of \$575 million of 3.375% Convertible Senior Notes due 2033 (the "Securities") to qualified institutional buyers pursuant to Rule 144A under the Securities Act of 1933. The Securities were issued under an Indenture dated as of January 1, 1988 between the Registrant and The Bank of New York, as trustee (the "Trustee"), as supplemented by a First Supplemental Indenture thereto dated as of September 6, 1991, a Second Supplemental Indenture thereto dated as of September 20, 1991, a Third Supplemental Indenture thereto dated as of January 26, 1993, a Fourth Supplemental Indenture thereto dated as of March 1, 1993 and a Fifth Supplemental Indenture thereto dated as of October 10, 2003 (as so supplemented, the "Indenture"). The Registrant is filing as exhibits to this Current Report on Form 8-K certain agreements and instruments related to the foregoing transactions, which documents are listed on the exhibit list under Item 7 of this Form 8-K.
