Explanatory Note

Capitalized terms used in this Statement but not defined herein shall have the respective meanings given to such terms in Amendment No. 13.

Item 3. Source and Amount of Funds & Other Consideration

Item 3 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

On July 22 through July 24, 2015, Institutional Partners III acquired an aggregate of 800,000 shares of Common Stock in open market purchases for aggregate consideration (excluding commissions) of approximately \$14,823,822.

Item 5. Interests in Securities of the Issuer

Item 5 is hereby amended by deleting such item in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

The percentages set forth below are calculated based on 81,500,808 shares of Common Stock outstanding as of May 31, 2015, as disclosed by the Issuer on its Annual Report on Form 10-Q filed on June 4, 2015.

(a) (i) Master Account may be deemed to be the beneficial owner of 1,099,046 shares of Common Stock held for its own account (approximately 1.3% of the total number of shares of Common Stock outstanding, calculated in accordance with Rule 13d 3(d)(1)(i) under the Act).

(ii) Capital Partners (100) may be deemed to be the beneficial owner of 145,426 shares of Common Stock held for its own account (approximately 0.2% of the total number of shares of Common Stock outstanding, calculated in accordance with Rule 13d 3(d)(1)(i) under the Act).

(iii) Advisors may be deemed to be the beneficial owner of 1,244,472 shares of Common Stock (approximately 1.5% of the total number of shares of Common Stock outstanding, calculated in accordance with Rule 13d 3(d)(1)(i) under the Act). This number consists of (A) 1,099,046 shares of Common Stock held for the account of Master Account and (B) 145,426 shares of Common Stock held for the account of Capital Partners (100).

(iv) Institutional Partners III may be deemed to be the beneficial owner of 14,980,528 shares of Common Stock held for its own account (approximately 18.4% of the total number of shares of Common Stock outstanding, calculated in accordance with Rule 13d 3(d)(1)(i) under the Act).

(v) Institutional Advisors III may be deemed to be the beneficial owner of 14,980,528 shares of Common Stock (approximately 18.4% of the total number of shares of Common Stock outstanding, calculated in accordance with Rule 13d 3(d)(1)(i) under the Act). This number consists of 14,980,528 shares of Common Stock held for the account of Institutional Partners III.

(vi) Fund Management may be deemed to be the beneficial owner of 16,225,000 shares of Common Stock (approximately 19.9% of the total number of shares of Common Stock outstanding, calculated in accordance with Rule 13d 3(d)(1)(i) under the Act). This number consists of all of the shares of Common Stock otherwise described in this Item 5 by virtue of Fund Management s investment management agreement with Master Account, Capital Partners (100) and Institutional Partners III.

(vii) MHR Holdings may be deemed to be the beneficial owner of 16,225,000 shares of Common Stock (approximately 19.9% of the total number of shares of Common Stock outstanding, calculated in accordance with Rule 13d 3(d)(1)(i) under the Act). This number consists of all of the shares of Common Stock otherwise described in this Item 5 by virtue of MHR Holdings position as the managing member of Fund Management.

(viii) Dr. Rachesky may be deemed to be the beneficial owner of 16,247,942 shares of Common Stock (approximately 19.9% of the total number of shares of Common Stock outstanding, calculated in accordance with Rule 13d 3(d)(1)(i) under the Act). This number consists of (A) all of the shares of Common Stock otherwise described in this Item 5 by virtue of Dr. Rachesky s position as the managing member of each of Advisors, Institutional Advisors III and MHR Holdings, (B) 6,180 shares of Common Stock held directly, (C) 15,000 shares of Common Stock that can be obtained upon the exercise of certain stock options, and (D) 1,762 shares of Common Stock that can be obtained upon the settlement of phantom stock units.

(b) (i) Master Account may be deemed to have (x) the sole power to direct the disposition of 1,099,046 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Master Account as described above, and (y) the sole power to direct the voting of 1,099,046 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Master Account as described above.

(ii) Capital Partners (100) may be deemed to have (x) the sole power to direct the disposition of 145,426 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Capital Partners (100) as described above, and (y) the sole power to direct the voting of 145,426 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Capital Partners (100) as described above.

(iii) Advisors may be deemed to have (x) the sole power to direct the disposition of 1,244,472 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Advisors as described above, and (y) the sole power to direct the voting of 1,244,472 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Advisors as described above.

(iv) Institutional Partners III may be deemed to have (x) the sole power to direct the disposition of 14,980,528 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Institutional Partners III as described above, and (y) the sole power to direct the voting of 14,980,528 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Institutional Partners III as described above.

(v) Institutional Advisors III may be deemed to have (x) the sole power to direct the disposition of 14,980,528 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Institutional Advisors III as described above, and (y) the sole power to direct the voting of 14,980,528 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Institutional Advisors III as described above.

(vi) Fund Management may be deemed to have (x) the sole power to direct the disposition of 16,225,000 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Fund Management as described above, and (y) the sole power to direct the voting of 16,225,000 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Fund Management as described above.

(vii) MHR Holdings may be deemed to have (x) the sole power to direct the disposition of 16,225,000 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by MHR Holdings as described above, and (y) the sole power to direct the voting of 16,225,000 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by MHR Holdings as described above.

(viii) Dr. Rachesky may be deemed to have (x) the sole power to direct the disposition of 16,247,942 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Dr. Rachesky as described above, and (y) the sole power to direct the voting of 16,247,942 shares of Common Stock which may be deemed to be beneficially owned by Dr. Rachesky as described above.

(c) See Annex A. In addition, on June 30, 2015, Dr. Rachesky was granted a phantom stock unit director grant in the amount of 1,380.91 shares of the Issuer's Common Stock at a price of \$22.63 per share. The phantom stock units were accrued under the Issuer's directors deferred compensation plan and are to be settled in Issuer Common Stock per Dr. Rachesky's election made at the time of the election to defer compensation.
